

Gunnebo SafeCoin D 700

Wall-mounted self-service coin roll dispenser for banks and retail

The SafeCoin D family of machines sets a new standard for coin roll dispensers. SafeCoin D 700 is a compact selfservice solution with colour screen and softkeys for around-the-clock dispensing of coin rolls.

The machine accepts banknotes and coins and exchanges them for coin rolls, coins or notes of another denomination. It can store between 200-525 coin rolls per module and between 1000–2000 coins per hopper. In order to meet the demands that 24-hour-a-day service requires, SafeCoin D 700 is built using only the latest and most reliable components.

Configuration of the terminal is flexible to allow clients to choose a machine which suits their own particular

requirements. The client can select the required functions and components from the configuration options available.

Design

Depending on requirements, SafeCoin D 700 can be installed as a through-the-wall or in-the-wall unit. The machine can be accessed from the rear, making it easy for staff or CIT companies to empty or fill and for technicians to service.

To make each transaction quick and simple for the end user, a colour screen and softkeys guides the customer through the process.

Remote Monitoting

SafeCoin software can be connected to the most common monitoring platforms and provides real-time monitoring, transaction control, device status overview and retrieval of statistical data.

Automated emails triggered by freely configurable events are also possible. With the local area network as a standard, the machine is equipped with an integrated web-server based monitoring system.
